

The **New** New York Skyline

Manhattan is in the midst of an unprecedented boom in tall buildings. Before 2004, Manhattan was home to 28 skyscrapers 700 feet and taller. Since then, an additional 13 have been built, 15 are under construction, and 19 are proposed—47 more in all. These additions are rapidly—and radically—changing the skyline.

42 Trinity Place

1,015 ft / NA

Most recent plans for this site show a 1,015-foot, 80-story tower, but the developers have acquired air rights that would allow it to rise even higher.

50 West

Height: 778 ft / Completion: 2017

This condominium tower will have a curved glass facade of floor-to-ceiling windows. After Superstorm Sandy the design was altered to raise the lobby level three feet.
